A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NEWBERRY PROVIDING FOR FLORIDA PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION REPORTING FOR; STANDARDS FOR THE PROMOTION, ENCOURAGEMENT, AND EXPANSION OF THE USE OF RENEWABLE ENERGY RESOURCES AND ENERGY CONSERVATION AND EFFICIENCY MEASURES

WHEREAS, City of Newberry is required by Section 366.92(5), Florida Statutes, to develop standards for the promotion, encouragement, and expansion of the use of renewable energy resources and energy conservation and efficiency measures; and

WHEREAS, on or before April 1, 2009, and annually thereafter City of Newberry must submit to the Florida Public Service Commission (the "FPSC") a report that identifies such standards; and

WHEREAS, the FPSC has submitted to the Florida Legislature for ratification a draft Renewable Portfolio Standard ("RPS") rule applicable to Florida's investor-owned electric utilities; and

WHEREAS, City of Newberry believes that it is in the best interest of its customers to develop renewable energy standards and energy conservation and efficiency measures in an environmentally responsible, reliable, and cost effective manner that takes into consideration the renewable and conservation direction of the state of Florida, as evidenced by the RPS rule applicable to IOUs; and

WHEREAS, City of Newberry is a member of Florida Municipal Power Agency's All-Requirements Power Supply Project (the "ARP Project"), through which City of Newberry purchases all of its power supply requirements; and

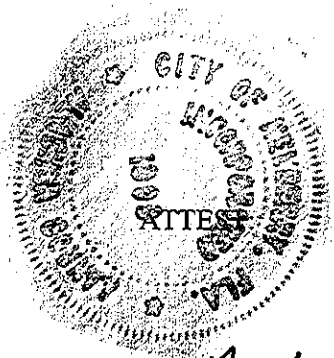
NOW THEREFORE, in accordance with Section 366.92(5), Florida Statutes, and in an effort to promote and expand the use of renewable energy resources and energy conservation and efficiency measures, City of Newberry hereby establishes the following guiding principles and standards: City of Newberry will:

- Monitor the rulemaking process at the Public Service Commission and the Florida Legislature with regard to the development of a renewable portfolio standard for investor owned utilities in the state; and, upon its final adoption, develops a comprehensive renewable portfolio standard that reflects the direction of the Legislature for the State of Florida.

- Encourage our wholesale power provider, the Florida Municipal Power Agency's All-Requirements Power Supply Project, to develop clean, renewable energy projects, or other means by which to expand the use of energy resources in a manner that reflects the direction of the Legislature and provides customers with environmentally responsible, reliable, and cost-effective power.
- Continue to promote energy conservation and energy efficiency by providing customers with information, guidance, tools and support in their demand side energy efficiency and conservation efforts, including programs such as distributing energy conversation kits and providing access to the Energy Depot online energy audit program for conservation measures to reduce energy costs.
- Continue to identify methods to enhance energy efficiency in City of Newberry facilities and operations by taking measures to reduce line losses and improving efficiency of system, establishing Net Metering Tariff for customers who choose to install alternative energy sources and encourage our wholesale power provider, the Florida Municipal Power Agency's All-Requirements Power Supply Project, to do the same.

Section 1: This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
