TERMS AND CONDITION OF PARTICIPATION

Parent and Guardians are responsible for their conduct at all practices and games, any misconduct may result in your child's removal from the program. Any misconduct may also result in parent/guardian removal from property for a period of time. All misconduct will be judged from CODE OF CONDUCT paper to be signed on attached sheet.

1. There is a risk of injury in all sport activities. Each parent, guardian and participant MUST be aware of certain risks in participating in athletic programs. Parents/guardians should observe practices and games to assure SAFE conditions.
2. No player may participate in Newberry Recreation Programs until this registration form has been completed and returned to the Newberry Parks & Recreation Department along with registration fees.
3. City of Newberry provides funding for equipment and playing fields. Players and parents assume full responsibility for equipment assigned to the player during the current season. All equipment must be returned by the conclusion of the season. Equipment must be returned in the condition it was received, with the ordinary wear and tear kept in mind. IF EQUIPMENT IS NOT RETURNED BY PLAYER WITHIN THESE SAID TERMS, PARENTS/GUARDIANS AGREES TO PAY NEWBERRY PARKS & RECREATION FULL REPLACEMENT COSTS FOR LOST OR NON-RETURNED ITEMS.
4. Failure to abide by the by above terms and conditions will result in NO further participation in the Newberry Recreation Programs.

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR SPORTING EVENTS

1. I will remember that children participate to have fun, and that the game is for the youth, not adults.
2. I will inform the coach of any physical disability or ailment that may affect the safety of my child or the safety of others.
3. I (and my guests) will be positive role models for my child, and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy-and by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, officials, and spectators at every game, practice or other sporting events.
4. I (and my guests) will not engage in any unsportsmanlike conduct with any officials, coaches, players or parents, such as cooing or taunting, refusing to shake hands, or using profanity or gestures.
5. I will not encourage any behaviors or practices that would endanger the health and well-being of the athletes.
6. I will teach my child to play by the rules and to resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence.
7. Will demand that my child treat other players, coaches, officials and spectators with respect regardless of race, creed, sex or ability.
8. I will teach my child that one's best is more important than winning, so that my child will never feel defeated by the outcome of a game or his/her performance.
9. I will praise my child for competing fairly and trying hard, and make my child feel like a winner every time.
10. I will never ridicule or yell at my child or other participants for making a mistake or losing a competition.
11. I will emphasize skill development and practices, and how they benefit my child, over winning.
12. I will demand a sports environment for my child that is free from drugs, tobacco, and alcohol, and will refrain from their use at all sports events.
